Once we receive your complete application, all the required documents and the Admissions Fee, the appropriate Principal will review the application. Based on policy, parents of currently enrolled students receive the first opportunity to re-enroll their children for the new academic year. After May 1 2008, we will admit new students who qualify until such time as classes are full. Once a grade reaches the maximum student number, all new applicants go on a wait list in accordance with the admission categories outlined in the Admission Policy and the date and time we receive each completed application. A completed application is one that includes all required documents, all forms completed in full and the payment of the Application Fee.
