



Application For IB Diploma Scholarship Admission SY 2021-22

Required Documents

This document contains a checklist of the forms that you need to apply for an **IB Diploma Scholarship at IST**. Your application will be considered complete and ready for review once **all the information forms and supporting documentation** have been received. **Please note if applications are not complete by the February deadline date, they will not be considered.** These forms are available online (www.istafrica.com/admissions/financial-support). A complete application form includes the following items:

- ☐ The Application Form (download from website).
- ☐ Confidential School Report (download from website). Please ensure the completed form is **signed and stamped with your school stamp**.
- ☐ A copy of the child's passport, information page only.
For a child without a passport, a copy of the child's birth certificate.
- ☐ A copy of each parent's passport information page, birth certificate or NIDA Card.
- ☐ One (1) passport size current photo of the applicant.
- ☐ One copy of Mock Results and one copy of the National Form IV Exam Results or equivalent. In the absence of official results, the NECTA printout should be stamped and signed by the School.
- ☐ Previous School Records/Transcripts/Test Reports for the last three school years, where this applies (i.e. Form II, III and IV). If these records are not in English, please provide an official translation.
- ☐ Any psycho educational or special education evaluations/records, if applicable.

Final acceptance and admission to IST is based upon a review of all available information. You will be required to submit a medical form if your child is selected for a scholarship.

Selected IB Diploma Scholarship applicants will be invited to attend IST Masaki Campus for testing in early March. Following testing, selected applicants will then be invited to interview at IST Masaki Campus.

It is advisable to carry a copy of the academic records with you when you come to Dar es Salaam just in case your records were delayed in the mail.
